Drop-off and Pick-up Guidelines

- DO** pull all the way forward within the lane
- DO** make sure child(ren) are ready to leave the vehicle at the designated area during drop off
- DO** use crosswalks and obey safety rules
- DO** fill in all spaces when a car moves forward

- DO NOT** get out of your car
- DO NOT** cut cars in line; patiently wait your turn
- DO NOT** stop in the middle of a pick-up area to load/unload child(ren)
- DO NOT** park on crosswalks or on the bridge

If you need to get out of your car to help your child buckle/unbuckle your child is NOT ready to use the drop-off/pick-up line. Thank you for your cooperation



Parking Guideline to maximize parking spaces during pick-up

- GREEN** area: fits 4 cars. First car must pull all the way forward to the start of the line or else only 3 cars will fit in the area.
- BLUE** area: fits 2 cars. 1st car must pull all the way forward to the 1st orange barrier.
- YELLOW** area: fits 3 cars. 1st car must pull close to the crosswalk as they can.
- RED** and **PINK** area: cars must zipper and take turns getting to the yellow area.
- RED** area: only ONE car must be on that bridge AT ALL TIMES! A 2nd car waiting on the bridge blocks cars trying to go up or down the bridge. If you see a car already waiting on the bridge, DO NOT pull behind that car.
