Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up Safety Dos and Don'ts!

DO pull all the way forward within the designated lane.

DO make sure children are ready to leave the vehicle as you pull into the drop-off zone.

DO patiently wait your turn in line; all pick-ups are completed within 15 mins of the bell

DO pull in all the way when parking on the hill so the end of your car is within the white parking line. Not doing so creates hazards for cars driving up the hill to exit the area.

DO use the crosswalks.

DO NOT get out of your car in the drop-off/pick-up lane.

DO NOT pick-up or load your child in the middle of the road, or as you are double parked behind cars.

DO NOT ask your child to walk along the bridge or in the road and pick them up along the way.

DO NOT block the small passing bridge. Only ONE car is permitted on the bridge at any given time, and must be open for any traffic thru.

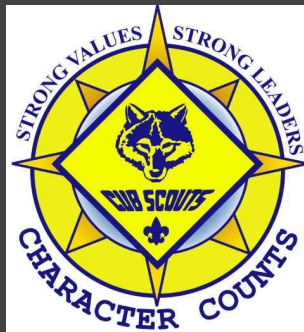

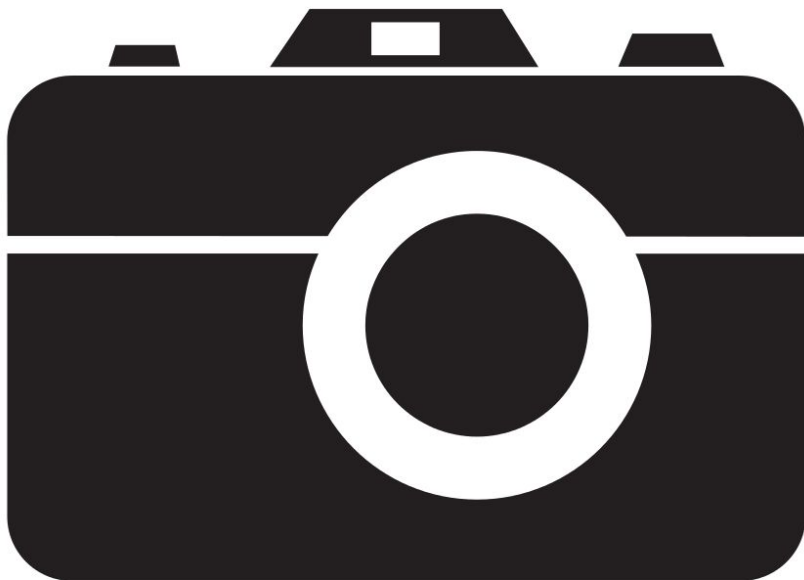
