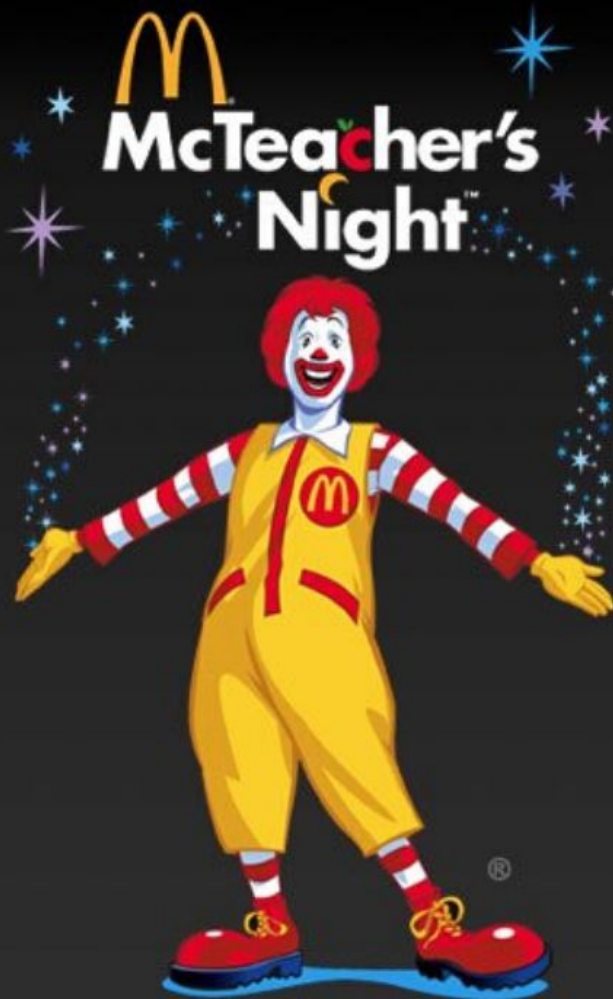
MAY DAY FUNDRAISER
